Recognition of Military Service and Prior Learning

At Kaplan University, you can accumulate up to 75% of your undergraduate degree credit through outside sources. In the 2014-2015 academic year, military-affiliated students accumulated an average of 30% of the credits needed to earn their degrees.⁵ Eligible sources of prior learning include:

- › Prior learning at nationally or regionally accredited schools
- › Pre-evaluated veterans' military occupational specialties (MOSs)
- › Exams such as College Level Examination Program (CLEP) and DANTES Subject Standardized Tests (DSST)
- › Course assessments
- › Experiential learning

Special Military Articulations

Kaplan University has evaluated a number of military occupations and mapped them to specific degree programs, which helps ensure your training transfers to Kaplan University as college credit. The result can greatly reduce the number of courses you need to complete the program. These programs require a review of your military transcripts. In most cases, you must have completed your training within 7 years of enrolling in your Kaplan University program. Programs include associate's and bachelor's degrees in the following areas of study:

- › Business
- › Criminal Justice
- › Fire Science and Emergency Management
- › Health Sciences
- › Information Technology
- › Liberal Studies

Building an Experiential Portfolio

Many veterans have vast amounts of skills they have obtained through their military service, civilian careers, or through work on committees, charitable organizations, or associations. However, without documentation and academic evaluation, many colleges have a difficult time awarding credit.

Kaplan University has the answer: we offer a portfolio development course that guides you in assessing, documenting, and finally submitting your experiences for official credit review.⁶ This could save you significant amounts of time and money. Please note: you should speak to an Advisor before taking this course, as much of your military experience may already be documented on your military transcript.

Tuition and Fees

At Kaplan University, we believe you have earned a quality education through your service and should not have to pay excessive out-of-pocket expenses to reach your educational goals. As a result, we offer significantly reduced tuition rates for veterans.

Program	Veteran Tuition Reduction	Technology Fees
Undergraduate Programs	38% per-credit tuition reduction (\$230 per credit)	\$200 per term
Graduate Programs	14% per-credit tuition reduction	\$100–200, depending on program

VA Benefits

Kaplan University accepts GI Bill funding for eligible students. For those eligible for the full Post-9/11 GI Bill, our tuition falls within the annual tuition cap. Kaplan University also participates in the Yellow Ribbon Program. Please check with the VA to determine the benefits for which you are eligible.

Military Family Scholarships

Kaplan University has teamed up with the American Freedom Foundation to offer scholarships to spouses and children of servicemembers and veterans.
